AUDIENCE QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS 34 35 A resident asked about the vacant lots in Silvercreek. 36 37 38 3. BUSINESS ITEMS 39 A. Discussion with LMP 40 Scott Carlson introduced himself, James Bennett, and Sam Martel. The regular service day is 41 Thursday. Mr. Bennett provided an update as to what has been completed on the property so far. 42 Mr. Martel went through the irrigation report. The Board discussed the irrigation proposals. 43 Supervisor Billington asked how the property looks, and Mr. Bennett said they found fungus and 44 are concerned about the health of some of the plants. Mr. Roberts said the CDD II just mulched 45 and asked when LMP will mulch. Mr. Bennett said he can provide a proposal to top off the 46

mulch. Supervisor Johnson said she is excited to have LMP on board. She said the biggest areas to focus on are the parks, dog waste bins, and weed growth around the park. Supervisor Behrens asked about putting white rocks under the gold mound duranta and wanted to make sure the fountain area is being maintained.

B. District Counsel Update

Mr. Vericker stated that there is a Board member that has not been to meetings in a while. He said he checked, and the Board member is currently registered. Mr. Vericker discussed the Board wanting to send a letter to the Board member. He said it is up to the Board if they would like management or Counsel to send the letter. The Board discussed and decided for management to send the letter.

Mr. Vericker also said that MBS is watching the interest rates. Supervisor Behrens asked if there is they anything can do as a District to help sell the seven lots. Mr. Vericker said they can do more as interested residents.

C. General Matters of the District

Ms. Hicks told the Board that a resident in Bridgeview had contacted management about an issue with the road in front of their home. Mr. Chang looked at it and provided a proposal for a survey as the first step. The Board discussed and would like to see if Mr. Chang thinks the issue is the tree, which would be the homeowner's responsibility. The Board also discussed the seepage in Glenbrook and that it is coming back up. Mr. Roberts said the next step is to see exactly where the clay is. Supervisor Behrens asked about the total amount that has been spent on the road in Glenbrook.
