The meeting will begin at <u>6:00 p.m.</u> Following the **Call to Order**, the meeting will proceed with the second section called **Vendor and Staff Reports**. This section will allow Vendors and District Engineer and Attorney to update Board on work and to present proposals. The third section is called **Business Items**. This section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motions, and votes on an item-by-item basis. The fourth section is called **Consent Agenda**. The Consent Agenda section contains items that require the review and approval of the District Board of Supervisors as a normal course of business. The fifth section will be **Management Reports**. This section allows the District Manager and Staff to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. In the event of a Public Hearing, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion, and vote.

The sixth section is called **Supervisor Requests**. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet the District's needs. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING.

Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 873-7300 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting. Public workshops sessions may be advertised and held in an effort to provide informational services. These sessions allow staff or consultants to discuss a policy or business matter in a more informal manner and allow for lengthy presentations prior to scheduling the item for approval. Typically, no motions or votes are made during these sessions.

Subject: Watergrass CDD 1 District boundary issue

Gene,

After doing some research that has included reviewing both the Watergrass CDD 1 & CDD 2 ordinances to establish, I can conclude that the area north of Overpass Road is within the CDD 2 District limits based on ordinance 13-06 to establish CDD 1 that I sent to you on 9/23/2021 and the attached excerpt from ordinance 13-05 to establish CDD 2 (CDD 2 parcels are shaded yellow).

The same district limit maps are shown on both CDD 1 & 2's website (also attached) and they are consistent with both ordinance 13-05 & 13-06. Parcels C-1 & C-2 are within the limits of CDD 2 and, therefore, should be CDD 2 parcels – not CDD 1.

On the property appraiser's website, the parcel with the ponds (Tract B7) on the north side of Overpass Road west of the community pool/center, does appear to indicate CDD I ownership if you look at the mailing address but it also says that the parcel is within Watergrass II.



The original property transfer occurred on 8/10/2011 from the developer to Watergrass CDD BEFORE CDD I & II were created (attached). I believe that the ownership of this parcel (Tract B7) was incorrectly recorded as CDD I instead of CDD 2 as it should have been per the establishment documents for CDD 1 & 2. In other words, it was an error but the parcel (Tract B7) is definitely within CDD 2 and should be owned by CDD 2 per the ordinance.

WITNESSETH: That Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 Dollars (\$10.00), to it in hand paid and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, and sold to the Grantee forever, the real property (the "Property") situated in Pasco County, Florida, legally described below:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WATERGRASS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT II PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 190, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORITY AND POWER OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE DISTRICT BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR FUNCTIONS OF THE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, CKB Development, LLC, (the "Petitioner") has petitioned the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners (the "County") to adopt an ordinance establishing the boundaries of the WaterGrass Community Development District II (the "District") pursuant to Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, and granting certain special powers; and

WHEREAS, the County, in determining whether to establish the District boundaries, has considered and finds that all statements contained in the Petition to Establish the WaterGrass Community Development District II (the "Petition") are true and correct; and

WHEREAS, the County has considered and finds that the establishment of the District is not inconsistent with any applicable element or portion of the Pasco County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County has considered and finds that the area of land within the District is a sufficient size, is sufficiently compact, and is sufficiently contiguous to be developed as a functional interrelated community; and

WHEREAS, the County has considered and finds that the District is the best alternative for delivering the community development services and facilities to the area that will be served by the District; and

WHEREAS, the County has considered and finds that the community development services and facilities of the District will not be incompatible with the capacity and uses of existing local and regional community development services and facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the County has considered and finds that the area that will be served by the District is amenable to separate special-district government; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing on the Petition was held prior to the adoption of this Ordinance establishing the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pasco County, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Chapters 125 and 190, Florida Statutes (2012),

and under the home rule powers of the County.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS OF FACT

The foregoing Whereas clauses, incorporated herein, are true and correct.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY AND POWER OF THE DISTRICT

- a. There is hereby established the District, as depicted in Exhibit H of the Petition, and the external boundaries of which is described in Exhibit B of the Petition, which shall operate in accordance with those requirements as set forth in Florida Statutes, Chapters 189 and 190, the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980, as amended.
- b. The establishment of the District shall not affect any requirements for governmental approval of any construction within the District. Master Planned Unit Development conditions of approval of the WaterGrass MPUD Petition No. 6186, as may be amended, pertaining to land within the District shall remain in effect. All other State and local development regulations shall apply. Planning, environmental, and land development regulations shall apply to all development and construction within the District regardless of who undertakes the activity. Further, the District shall not have the authority to adopt a comprehensive plan, building code, or land development code.
- c. The District shall have no eminent domain powers outside its boundaries without first obtaining the expressed written approval of the Board of County Commissioners by resolution.
- d. The District shall comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 189, Florida Statutes, including, but not limited to, the requirement that a "Public Facilities Report" be made and submitted to the County in accordance with Section 189.415, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 4. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DISTRICT

The exclusive charter for the District shall be the uniform community development district charter as set forth in Florida Statutes 190 which includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- a. The District shall provide financial reports to the Department of Financial Services in the same form and in the same manner as all other political subdivisions, including the County.
- b. The District shall fully disclose information concerning the financing and maintenance of real property improvements undertaken by the District. Such information shall be made available to all existing and prospective residents of the WaterGrass Community Development District II and the County.
- c. All contracts for the initial sale of real property and residential units within the District shall disclose to the buyer the existence of the District and the District's authority to levy taxes and assessments. Both the text and the placement of the text in the contract of sale must appear as mandated by law.

- d. The District shall have the authority to pledge only the District's funds, revenues, taxes, and assessments to pay the District's indebtedness.
- e. All bonds issued by the District shall be secured by a trust agreement between the District and a corporate trustee or trustees.
- f. In the event of a default on District Bonds, the obligations of the District shall not constitute a debt or obligation of the County, any municipality, or the State.
- g. The District shall be subject to the Florida Constitution provision requiring approval of ad valorem taxes by referendum; the millage rate for such taxes shall be limited by statute. In addition to the millage cap, the aggregate principal amount of general obligation bonds outstanding at any one (1) time shall not exceed thirty-five (35) percent of the assessed value of the property within the District. Should the residents of the District impose ad valorem taxes upon themselves, such taxes shall be in addition to the County's and other ad valorem taxes and shall be assessed, levied, and collected in the same manner as the County's taxes.
- h. Rates, fees, rentals, and other charges for any facilities or services of the District shall be established only after a noticed public hearing.
- i. Within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this Ordinance, the District shall record a Notice of Establishment of District Boundaries in the property records of the County, which the said notice shall include at least the legal description of the property within the District and the notice required to be given to buyers of property within the District.

SECTION 5. BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DISTRICT

- a. The District Board of Supervisors shall exercise the powers and responsibilities granted to the District.
- b. The members of the District's Board of Supervisors shall be residents of Florida and citizens of the United States. The names of the five (5) persons designated to be the initial members of the Board of Supervisors as listed in Exhibit D of the Petition.
- c. After the Board of Supervisors shifts to being elected by the resident electors of the District, the supervisors shall also be residents and electors of the District.
- d. Candidates for the District's Board of Supervisors seeking election to office by the qualified electors of the District shall be subject to the same campaign financing disclosure requirements and oath of office requirements as candidates for any other public office.
- e. The compensation of each supervisor is limited to Two Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$200.00) per meeting (not to exceed Four Thousand Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars [\$4,800.00] per year), plus standard State travel and per diem expenses, unless a higher compensation is approved by a referendum of the residents of the District.
- f. All meetings of the District's Board of Supervisors, which shall include a minimum of four (4) times per year during evening hours, must be open to the public and governed by the Government-in-the-Sunshine requirements of Chapter 286, Florida Statutes.
- g. The District's Board of Supervisors shall follow Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, procedures in adopting rules.

h. The records of the District's Board of Supervisors must be open for public inspection by any person at any reasonable time, pursuant to Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and the said records shall be kept in the manner and in the place mandated by law.

SECTION 6. DISTRICT BUDGET

- a. The District budget shall be adopted annually by the District's Board of Supervisors, and prior to approval by the said Board, shall be the subject of a duly noticed public hearing at which the said Board must hear all objections to the budget.
- b. Proposed District budgets shall be submitted by the District's Board of Supervisors to the County at least sixty (60) days before adoption by the District's Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 7. FUNCTIONS OF THE DISTRICT

- a. The District may exercise the general powers provided in Section 190.011, Florida Statutes.
- b. The District may exercise the special powers for parks and recreation services and facilities, security services and facilities, and waste collection and disposal services pursuant to Sections 190.012(2)(a), 190.012(2)(d) and 190.012(2)(f), Florida Statutes.
- c. The powers and functions of the District do not replace, diminish, or obviate the applicability of any County ordinance to the property and the development of the said property, currently within the District, as described in Exhibit B, and as the said District might be expanded or contracted.

SECTION 8. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- a. The County may require, based upon the number of residential units planned within the District, that the District's community facilities be used to accommodate the establishment of a polling place by the Pasco County Supervisor of Elections.
- b. The County, at its option, may adopt a nonemergency ordinance providing a plan for the transfer of a specific community development service from the District to the County. The plan shall provide for the assumption and guarantee of the District debt that is related to the service and shall demonstrate the ability of the County to provide the service as efficiently as the District at a level of quality equal to or higher than that actually delivered by the District and at charge equal to or lower than the actual charge by the District.
- c. The District shall not levy assessments on any property, lying within the boundaries of the District, either owned or to be owned by the County or the District School Board of Pasco County. All applicable documents pertaining to the undertaking of funding and construction by the District shall reflect the following: (1) all District-related assessments shall not apply to any property either owned or to be owned by the County or the District School Board of Pasco County; and (2) no debt or obligation of such District shall constitute a burden on any property either owned or to be owned by the County or District School Board of Pasco County.

Any and all property owned by the District shall be subject to, and the District shall pay, all County imposed user fees, including but not limited to stormwater utility and solid

waste disposal fees, whether or not such fees are collected via the non-ad valorem assessment method. Further, property within the boundaries of the District may be subject to existing or future taxes, assessments, or user fees imposed by the County, or any existing or future dependent district of the County, and such taxes, assessments, and user fees could be equal in priority, or superior to, the District's assessments and fees. Such taxes, assessments and user fees shall not be considered inconsistent with, or an impairment of, the financial obligations of the District, and the possibility and priority of such taxes, assessments, and user fees shall be disclosed in all applicable documents pertaining to the undertaking of funding and construction by the District.

d. The Petition to Establish the WaterGrass Community Development District II is attached hereto in its entirety as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.

SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY

To the extent that any portion of this ordinance is in conflict with Chapter 190, Florida Statutes or any other Florida Statute, as amended, then the Florida Statutes shall govern, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be construed as not having contained such section, subsection, sentence, clause, or provision and shall not be affected by such holding.

Petition to Establish Watergrass Community Development District II

Petitioner, CKB Development, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, (herein referred to as "Petitioner"), petitions the Board of County Commissioners of Pasco County, Florida pursuant to the Uniform Community Development District Act of 1980, Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, to adopt an ordinance establishing a community development district, to be known as the Watergrass Community Development District II (the "District"), and designating the land area for which the District would manage and finance the delivery of basic services, and states as follows:

- Petitioner is CKB Development, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, having a post office address of 2940 Sports Corc Circle, Wesley Chapel, Florida 33544.
- 2. The land area to be served by the District is a parcel of unimproved real property containing approximately 771.127 acres. All of the land in the proposed District is in the unincorporated portion of Pasco County. A map showing the general location of the project and an aerial photograph are attached as Composite Exhibit A.
- A metes and bounds legal description of the external boundaries of the District and a description sketch are attached as Composite Exhibit B.
- 4. The written consent to the establishment of the District by the landowner, as defined in section 190.003(13), Florida Statutes, of 100% of the real property to be included in and served by the District, are attached as Composite Exhibits C-1 through C-5. Section 190.005(1)(a)2, Florida Statutes.
- 5. The five persons designated to serve as the initial members of the board of supervisors of the District are identified in Exhibit D attached hereto. These initial supervisors shall serve on the board until replaced by elected members as provided by Section 190.006, Florida Statutes. All of the initial supervisors are residents of the State of Florida and citizens of the United States of America. Section 190.005(1)(a)3, Florida Statutes.

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- 6. The proposed name of the District is the Watergrass Community Development District II (hereinafter in the attached exhibits referred to as "Watergrass CDD II"). Section 190.005(1)(a)4, Florida Statutes.
- 7. The major trunk water mains, sewer interceptors and outfalls currently in existence on the property to be served by the District are identified on **Exhibit E** attached hereto. Section 190.005(1)(a)5, Florida Statutes.
- The proposed timetables and related estimates of cost to construct District services and facilities, and proposed infrastructure plan based upon available data, are attached as composite Exhibit F. Section 190.005(1)(a)6, Florida Statutes.
- 9. The statement of estimated regulatory costs of the granting of this petition and the establishment of the District pursuant thereto together with an analysis of alternatives for delivering community development services and facilities, are attached as Exhibit G, Section 190.005(1)(a)8, Florida Statutes.
- 10. The future general distribution, location, and extent of public and private uses of land proposed for the area within the District have been incorporated into the adopted and approved Pasco County Comprehensive Plan Land Use Element. The proposed land uses are consistent with the local government comprehensive plan. Section 190.005(1)(a)7, Florida Statutes. A copy of the pertinent portion of the Pasco County Land Use Element is attached as Exhibit H.
- 11. The property within the proposed District is amenable to operation as an independent special district for the following reasons:
- (a) Establishment of the District and all land uses and services planned within the proposed District are consistent with applicable elements or portions of the State Comprehensive Plan and all elements of the adopted and approved Pasco County Comprehensive Plan.
- (b) The area of land within the proposed District is of sufficient size and is sufficiently compact and contiguous to be developed as one functional interrelated community.
- (c) The District provides the best mechanism for delivering community development services and facilities to the proposed community. The Petitioner expects that the

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establishment of the proposed District will promote development of the land within the District by providing for a more efficient use of resources. That development will in turn benefit Pasco County and its residents outside the District by increasing the ad valorem tax base of Pasco County and generating water and wastewater impact fees which will assist Pasco County to meet its obligations to repay certain bonded indebtedness and transportation and other impact fees as well.

- (d) The community development services and facilities of the District will be compatible with the capacity and use of existing local and regional community development services and facilities. In addition, the District will provide a perpetual entity capable of making reasonable provisions for the operation and maintenance of the District services and facilities.
- 12. The Petitioner is also requesting the County to grant the District the following special powers under section 190.012(2), Florida Statutes: (1) Parks and Recreation powers in accordance with section 190.012(2)(a), Florida Statutes, (2) Security Powers in accordance with section 190.012(2)(d), Florida Statutes, and (3) Waste Collection and Disposal Powers in accordance with section 190.012(2)(f), Florida Statutes.

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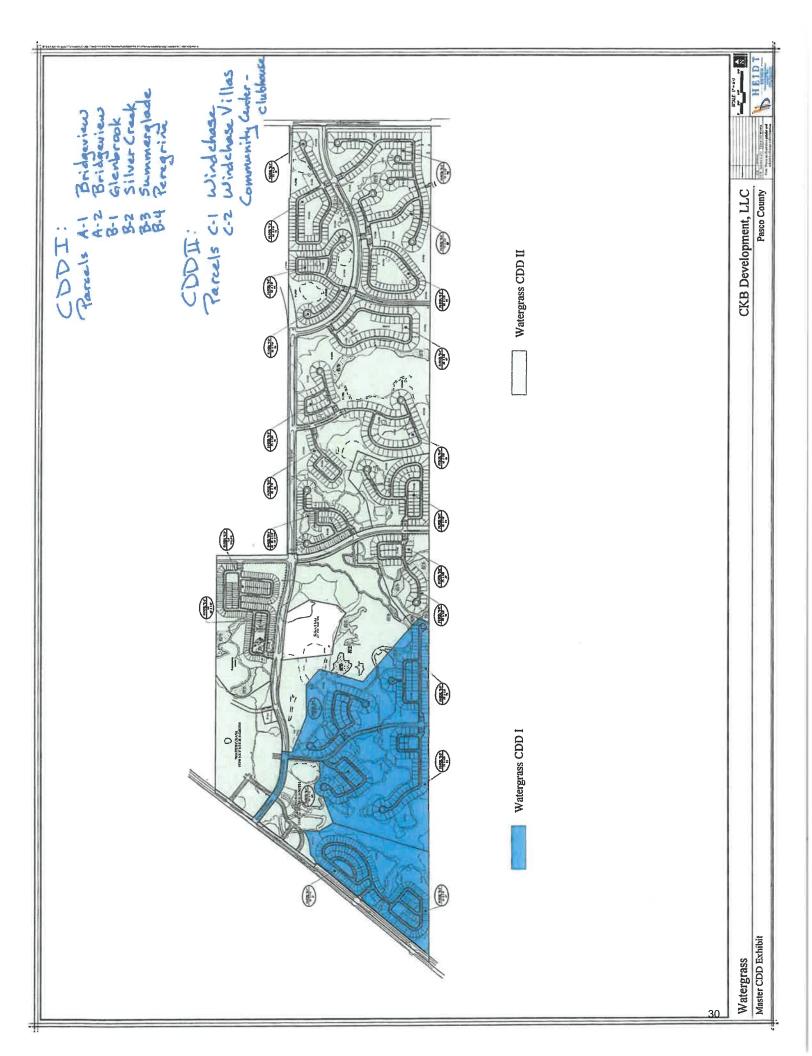


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RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WATERGRASS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT I (THE "DISTRICT") AUTHORIZING THE REFUNDING OF **ASSESSMENT** THE DISTRICT'S **SPECIAL** REVENUE SERIES 2007A; APPROVING THE FORM OF ESCROW DEPOSIT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND WELLS FARGO BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, AS **ESCROW AGENT** (THE "ESCROW AGREEMENT"); AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN AND THE SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE ESCROW AGREEMENT AND **ACTIONS TAKE** ALL AND **ENTER** INTO ALL AGREEMENTS REQUIRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE REFUNDING OF THE REFUNDED **BONDS:** AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of Watergrass Community Development District I, f/k/a WaterGrass Community Development District (the "District") has previously issued, sold and delivered its Watergrass Community Development District Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2007A (the "Series 2007A Bonds") under and pursuant to a Master Trust Indenture, dated as of October 1, 2005, as supplemented by a Second Supplemental Trust Indenture, dated as of May 1, 2007 (together, the "Indenture") from the District to Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, as ultimate successor in trust to Wachovia Bank, National Association, as trustee (the "Trustee"); and

WHEREAS, the Series 2007A Bonds are payable from and secured in part by revenues derived from certain non-ad valorem special assessments imposed, levied and collected on behalf of the District by WaterGrass Community Development District II ("WaterGrass II") on certain lands located entirely within the boundaries of WaterGrass II; and

WHEREAS, WaterGrass II desires to currently refund all of the Outstanding Series 2007A Bonds (hereinafter referred to as the "Refunded Bonds") to achieve debt service savings; and

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate the refunding of the Refunded Bonds, it is necessary to approve the form of an Escrow Deposit Agreement and to provide for various other matters with respect to the refunding and redemption of the Refunded Bonds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. **Definitions.** All words and phrases used herein in capitalized form, unless otherwise defined herein, shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Indenture.
- 2. Refunding of Refunded Bonds; Execution and Delivery of Other Instruments. The Board hereby authorizes and approves the refunding of the Refunded Bonds by WaterGrass II. The Board hereby authorizes the Chairman and the Secretary of WaterGrass II to execute and deliver, receive or enter into such agreements, contracts, documents, instruments, certificates and proceedings incident thereto or necessary in order to effect the refunding of the Refunded Bonds.
- 3. Approval of Form of Escrow Deposit Agreement; Appointment of Escrow Agent; Transfer of Funds. The Escrow Deposit Agreement (the "Escrow Agreement"), between the District and Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, relating to the Refunded Bonds is hereby approved and shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, subject to such changes, additions, deletions and insertions as shall be approved by the Chairman, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof. The Chairman is hereby authorized to execute and the Secretary is authorized to attest the Escrow Agreement which, when executed and delivered by the District, shall be a legal, valid and binding obligation of the District, enforceable in accordance with its terms. Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, is hereby appointed as Escrow Agent under the Escrow Agreement.

Amounts on deposit in the Funds and Accounts for the Refunded Bonds shall be applied as directed by the Chairman in a certificate directed to the Escrow Agent, subject to the approval of Bond Counsel.

- 4. Other Actions. The Vice Chairman is hereby authorized to act in the stead of the Chairman in any undertaking authorized or required of the Chairman hereunder and any Assistant Secretary is hereby authorized to act in the stead of the Secretary in any undertaking authorized or required of the Secretary hereunder.
- 5. Approval of Prior Actions. All actions taken to date by the members of the Board and the officers, agents and consultants of the District on behalf of WaterGrass II in connection with the refunding of the Refunded Bonds are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.
- 6. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or ineffective for any reason, the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in full force and effect, it being expressly hereby found and declared that the remainder of this Resolution would have been adopted despite the invalidity or ineffectiveness of such section, paragraph, clause or provision.

7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

ESCROW DEPOSIT AGREEMENT

ESCROW DEPOSIT AGREEMENT (this "Agreement"), dated as of [Closing Date], between WATERGRASS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT I, f/k/a WaterGrass Community Development District, a duly created and validly existing local unit of special purpose government (the "District"), and WELLS FARGO BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION (the "Escrow Agent"), a national banking association authorized to accept and execute trusts of the character herein set out, with its designated office located at [123 S. Broad Street, Suite #1500, MAC: Y1379-157, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19109], Attention: Corporate Trust Department.

WHEREAS, the District has heretofore issued, sold and delivered its WaterGrass Community Development District Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2007A (the "Series 2007A Bonds") currently outstanding in the aggregate principal amount of \$[5,400,000] (the Outstanding principal amount of such Series 2007A Bonds hereinafter referred to as the "Refunded Bonds") under and pursuant to the terms of a Master Trust Indenture, dated as of October 1, 2005 (the "Master Indenture"), from the District to Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, as ultimate successor in trust to Wachovia Bank, National Association, as trustee (the "Trustee"), as supplemented by a Second Supplemental Trust Indenture, dated as of May 1, 2007 (the "Second Supplemental Indenture" and together with the Master Indenture, the "Indenture"), from the District to the Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the Series 2007A Bonds are payable from and secured in part by revenues derived from certain non-ad valorem special assessments imposed, levied and collected on behalf of the District by WaterGrass Community Development District II ("WaterGrass II") on certain lands located entirely within the boundaries of WaterGrass II; and

WHEREAS, WaterGrass II desires to currently refund such Refunded Bonds to achieve debt service savings; and

WHEREAS, WaterGrass II has authorized the issuance, sale and delivery of its \$[Bond Amount] WaterGrass Community Development District II Special Assessment Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2021 (the "Series 2021 Bonds") pursuant to a Master Trust Indenture, dated as of September 1, 2018, as supplemented by a Second Supplemental Trust Indenture, dated as of [December 1, 2021], each from WaterGrass II to U.S. Bank National Association, as trustee, to secure the issuance of the Series 2021 Bonds and to set forth the terms of the Series 2021 Bonds, a portion of the proceeds of which, together with certain other legally available moneys of the District, will be used to discharge the pledge of and lien of the Indenture in favor of the holders of such Refunded Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the issuance of the Series 2021 Bonds, the deposit of cash into an escrow deposit trust fund to be held by the Escrow Agent and the discharge of the pledge of and lien of the Indenture in favor of the holders of such Refunded Bonds shall occur as a simultaneous transaction; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is intended to effectuate such simultaneous transaction;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION 1. PREAMBLES. The District represents that the recitals stated above are true and correct and the same are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. RECEIPT OF INDENTURE AND VERIFICATION REPORT. The Escrow Agent hereby acknowledges receipt of true and correct copies of the Indenture and this Agreement. The applicable and necessary provisions of the Indenture, including, without limitation, Articles III and XII of the Master Indenture, are incorporated herein by reference. The Escrow Agent also acknowledges receipt of the final numbers (the "Final Numbers") prepared by MBS Capital Markets, LLC, showing its calculations of the amount needed to refund the Refunded Bonds at the Redemption Price as set forth in the Final Numbers, as verified by the verification report of [Verification Agent], a firm of independent certified public accountants, dated [Closing Date] (the "Verification Report"). The Escrow Agent has no responsibility for the production, review or accuracy of either the Final Numbers or the Verification Report. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in the Indenture.

SECTION 3. DISCHARGE OF LIEN OF HOLDERS OF REFUNDED BONDS. In accordance with Articles III and XII of the Master Indenture, simultaneously herewith, the lien of the Indenture and all covenants, agreements and other obligations of the District to the Owners of the Refunded Bonds shall cease, terminate and become void and be discharged and satisfied.

SECTION 4. ESTABLISHMENT OF ESCROW FUND. There is hereby created and established with the Escrow Agent a special, segregated and irrevocable escrow deposit trust fund designated the "WaterGrass Community Development District Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2007A Escrow Deposit Trust Fund" (the "Escrow Fund"). The Escrow Fund shall be held in the custody of the Escrow Agent as a trust fund for the benefit of the holders of the Refunded Bonds, separate and apart from other funds and accounts of the District, WaterGrass II and the Escrow Agent. The Escrow Agent hereby accepts the Escrow Fund and acknowledges the receipt of and deposit to the credit of the Escrow Fund the sum of \$[BP] received from WaterGrass II from proceeds of the Series 2021 Bonds (the "Bond Proceeds") and the sum of \$[DM] received from the District from other available funds

(the "District Moneys"), c	onsisting of \$[$_]$ transferred from the 2007A Rese	erve

SECTION 5. DEPOSIT OF MONEYS IN ESCROW FUND. The District hereby directs, and the Escrow Agent acknowledges, that the Bond Proceeds and the District Moneys deposited with the Escrow Agent pursuant to Section 4 above (the "Cash Deposit") shall be held in the Escrow Fund uninvested in cash and neither the District nor the Escrow Agent shall otherwise invest or reinvest any moneys in the Escrow Fund.

SECTION 6. SUFFICIENCY OF CASH DEPOSIT. In reliance upon the Final Numbers and the Verification Report, the District represents that the Cash Deposit is sufficient such that moneys will be available to the Escrow Agent in amounts sufficient and at the times required to pay the amounts of principal of, redemption premium, if any, and interest due and to become due on the Refunded Bonds as described in Schedule A attached hereto. If the Cash Deposit shall be insufficient to make such payments, the District shall timely deposit to the Escrow Fund, solely from legally available funds of the District, such additional amounts as may be required to pay the Refunded Bonds as described in Schedule A attached hereto. Notice of any insufficiency shall be given by the Escrow Agent to the District as promptly as possible, but the Escrow Agent shall in no manner be responsible for the District's failure to make such deposits.

SECTION 7. CASH DEPOSIT IN TRUST FOR HOLDERS OF REFUNDED BONDS. The deposit of the Cash Deposit in the Escrow Fund shall constitute an irrevocable deposit of cash in trust solely for the payment of the principal of, redemption premium, if any, and interest on the Refunded Bonds at such times and in such amounts as set forth in Schedule A attached hereto, and the Cash Deposit shall be used solely for such purpose.

ESCROW FUND. The District hereby directs, and the Escrow Agent hereby agrees, that it will take all actions required to be taken by it under the provisions of the Indenture, including the timely transfer of, but solely from funds on deposit in the Escrow Fund, money to the Paying Agent for the Refunded Bonds as provided in the Indenture, in order to effectuate this Agreement and to pay the Refunded Bonds in the amounts and at the times provided in Schedule A attached hereto. The Cash Deposit shall be used to pay the principal of, redemption premium, if any, and interest on the Refunded Bonds as the same may mature or be redeemed. If any payment date shall be a day on which either the Paying Agent for the Refunded Bonds or the Escrow Agent is not open for the acceptance or delivery of funds, then the Escrow Agent shall transfer moneys to the Paying Agent on the next business day. The liability of the Escrow Agent for the payment of the principal of, redemption premium, if any, and interest on the Refunded Bonds pursuant to this Agreement shall be

limited to the application of the Cash Deposit available for such purposes in the Escrow Fund.

SECTION 9. ESCROW FUND SHALL CONTINUE IN EFFECT. The Escrow Fund shall continue in effect until the date upon which the Escrow Agent makes the final payment to the Paying Agent for the Refunded Bonds in an amount sufficient to pay the Refunded Bonds as described in Schedule A attached hereto, whereupon the Escrow Agent shall transfer all remaining money in the Escrow Fund, if any, to the District.

SECTION 10. REDEMPTION OF REFUNDED BONDS. The District hereby irrevocably instructs the Escrow Agent, in its capacity as Trustee, to give or cause to be given at the appropriate times the notice or notices required by the Indenture in connection with the redemption of the Refunded Bonds in accordance with Schedule A attached hereto, in the form customarily used by the Trustee for such notices.

SECTION 11. DEFEASANCE OF REFUNDED BONDS. Concurrently with the deposit of the Cash Deposit set forth in Section 4 hereof, the District represents that, in reliance upon the Verification Report, the Refunded Bonds shall be deemed to have been paid within the meaning and with the effect expressed in Article XII of the Master Indenture. The District hereby irrevocably instructs the Escrow Agent, in its capacity as Trustee, to give or cause to be given the notice or notices required by the Indenture in connection with the defeasance of the Refunded Bonds. A form notice of defeasance is attached hereto as Schedule B.

SECTION 12. ESCROW FUND IRREVOCABLE. The Escrow Fund hereby created shall be irrevocable and the holders of the Refunded Bonds shall have an express lien on the Cash Deposit deposited in the Escrow Fund pursuant to the terms hereof and any interest earnings thereon until paid out, used and applied in accordance with this Agreement and the Indenture. Neither the District nor the Escrow Agent shall cause nor permit any other lien or interest whatsoever to be imposed upon the Escrow Fund.

SECTION 13. AMENDMENTS TO AGREEMENT. This Agreement is made for the benefit of the District and the holders from time to time of the Refunded Bonds and it shall not be repealed, revoked, altered or amended without the written consent of all such holders and the written consent of the Escrow Agent and the District; provided, however, that the District and the Escrow Agent may, without the consent of, or notice to, such holders, enter into such agreements supplemental to this Agreement as shall not adversely affect the rights of such holders and as shall not be inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Agreement, for any one or more of the following purposes:

(a) to cure any ambiguity or formal defect or omission in this Agreement;

- (b) to grant, or confer upon, the Escrow Agent for the benefit of the holders of the Refunded Bonds, any additional rights, remedies, powers or authority that may lawfully be granted to, or conferred upon, such holders or the Escrow Agent; and
- (c) to subject to this Agreement additional funds, securities or properties.

The Escrow Agent shall be entitled to rely exclusively upon an unqualified opinion of nationally recognized Bond Counsel with respect to compliance with this Section 13, including the extent, if any, to which any change, modification or addition affects the rights of the holders of the Refunded Bonds, or that any instrument executed hereunder complies with the conditions and provisions of this Section 13.

SECTION 14. FEES **AND EXPENSES** OF **ESCROW** AGENT; **INDEMNIFICATION.** In consideration of the services rendered by the Escrow Agent under this Agreement, the District has paid to the Escrow Agent a one-time fee and expenses, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. The Escrow Agent shall have no lien whatsoever upon the Cash Deposit in said Escrow Fund for the payment of such fees and expenses. To the extent permitted by law and without waiving any privileges or immunities afforded to the District under Florida law, the District further agrees to indemnify and save the Escrow Agent, its agents and employees, harmless against any liabilities, obligations, losses, damages, penalties, claims, actions, suits, costs, expenses and disbursements of whatsoever kind or nature, which it may incur in the exercise and performance of its powers and duties hereunder, including legal expenses, and which are not due to its gross negligence or willful misconduct. This Section 14 shall survive the termination of this Agreement, or, as to the Escrow Agent, its resignation or removal.

Whenever the Escrow Agent shall deem it necessary or desirable that a matter be proved or established prior to taking, suffering or omitting any action under this Agreement, such matter may be deemed to be conclusively established by a certificate signed by an authorized officer of the District. The Escrow Agent may conclusively rely, as to the correctness of statements, conclusions and opinions therein, upon any certificate, report, opinion or other document furnished to the Escrow Agent pursuant to any provision of this Agreement; the Escrow Agent shall be protected and shall not be liable for acting or proceeding, in good faith, upon such reliance; and the Escrow Agent shall be under no duty to make any investigation or inquiry as to any statements contained or matters referred to in any such instrument. The Escrow Agent may, at the expense of the District, consult with counsel, who may be counsel to the District or independent counsel, with regard to legal questions, and the opinion of such counsel shall be full and complete authorization and protection in respect of any action taken or suffered by it hereunder in good faith in accordance herewith. Prior to retaining such independent counsel, the Escrow Agent shall notify the District of its intention to retain counsel.

The Escrow Agent and its successors, agents and servants shall not be held to any personal liability whatsoever, in tort, contract or otherwise, by reason of the execution and delivery of this Agreement, the establishment of the Escrow Fund, the acceptance and disposition of the various moneys and funds described herein, any payment, transfer or other application of funds by the Escrow Agent in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement or any act that is not grossly negligent, omission or error of the Escrow Agent made in good faith in the conduct of its duties. The Escrow Agent shall, however, be liable to the District and to holders of the Refunded Bonds to the extent of their respective damages for the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Escrow Agent which violates or fails to comply with the terms of this Agreement; provided, however, the foregoing shall not include payment for special or consequential damages or damages caused by a party other than the Escrow Agent. The duties and obligations of the Escrow Agent shall be determined by the express provisions of this Agreement.

SECTION 15. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF ESCROW AGENT. As soon as practicable after the Refunded Bonds are redeemed, the Escrow Agent shall forward in writing to the District a statement regarding the Escrow Fund, including the income, if any, earned therein and withdrawals of money therefrom, since the date of its establishment.

SECTION 16. RESIGNATION OR REMOVAL OF ESCROW AGENT. The Escrow Agent, at the time acting hereunder, may at any time resign and be discharged from the duties and obligations hereby created by giving not less than 45 days' written notice to the District and mailing notice thereof, specifying the date when such resignation will take effect, to the holders of all Refunded Bonds then outstanding, but no such resignation shall take effect unless a successor Escrow Agent shall have been appointed by the holders of a majority in aggregate principal amount of the Refunded Bonds then outstanding or by the District as hereinafter provided and such successor Escrow Agent shall have accepted such appointment, in which event such resignation shall take effect immediately upon the appointment and acceptance of a successor Escrow Agent.

The Escrow Agent may be replaced at any time by an instrument or concurrent instruments in writing, delivered to the Escrow Agent and signed by either the District or the holders of a majority in aggregate principal amount of the Refunded Bonds then outstanding. Such instrument shall provide for the appointment of a successor Escrow Agent, which appointment shall occur simultaneously with the removal of the Escrow Agent.

In the event the Escrow Agent hereunder shall resign or be removed, or be dissolved, or shall be in the course of dissolution or liquidation, or otherwise become incapable of acting hereunder, or in case the Escrow Agent shall be taken under the control of any public officer or officers, or of a receiver appointed by a court, a successor may be appointed by the holders of a majority in aggregate principal

amount of the Refunded Bonds then outstanding by an instrument or concurrent instruments in writing, signed by such holders, or by their attorneys in fact, duly authorized in writing; provided, nevertheless, that in any such event, the District shall appoint a temporary Escrow Agent to fill such vacancy until a successor Escrow Agent shall be appointed by the holders of a majority in aggregate principal amount of the Refunded Bonds then outstanding in the manner above provided, and any such temporary Escrow Agent so appointed by the District shall immediately and without further act be superseded by the Escrow Agent so appointed by such holders. The District shall mail notice of any such appointment made by it at the times and in the manner described in the first paragraph of this Section 16.

In the event that no appointment of a successor Escrow Agent or a temporary successor Escrow Agent shall have been made by such holders or the District pursuant to the foregoing provisions of this Section 16 within 45 days after written notice of resignation of the Escrow Agent has been given to the District, the holder of any of the Refunded Bonds or any retiring Escrow Agent may apply to any court of competent jurisdiction for the appointment of a successor Escrow Agent, and such court may thereupon, after such notice, if any, as it shall deem proper, appoint a successor Escrow Agent.

In the event of replacement or resignation of the Escrow Agent, the Escrow Agent shall have no further liability hereunder and the District shall, to the extent permitted by applicable law and without waiving any privileges or immunities afforded to the District under Florida law, indemnify and hold harmless Escrow Agent from any such liability, including costs or expenses incurred by Escrow Agent or its counsel.

No successor Escrow Agent shall be appointed unless such successor Escrow Agent shall be a corporation with trust powers organized under the banking laws of the United States or any State, and shall have at the time of appointment capital and surplus of not less than \$50,000,000 or trust assets under management of not less than \$500,000,000.

Subject to the immediately succeeding paragraph hereof, every successor Escrow Agent appointed hereunder shall execute, acknowledge and deliver to its predecessor and to the District an instrument in writing accepting such appointment hereunder and thereupon such successor Escrow Agent, without any further act, deed or conveyance, shall become fully vested with all the rights, immunities, powers, trusts, duties and obligations of its predecessor; but such predecessor shall nevertheless, on the written request of such successor Escrow Agent or the District, execute and deliver an instrument transferring to such successor Escrow Agent all the estates, properties, rights, powers and trust of such predecessor hereunder, except for the Escrow Agent's rights under Section 14 hereof; and every predecessor Escrow Agent shall deliver all securities and moneys held by it to its successor; provided, however, that before any such delivery is required to be made, all fees,

advances and expenses of the retiring or removed Escrow Agent shall be paid in full. Should any transfer, assignment or instrument in writing from the District be required by any successor Escrow Agent for more fully and certainly vesting in such successor Escrow Agent the estates, rights, powers and duties hereby vested or intended to be vested in the predecessor Escrow Agent, any such transfer, assignment and instruments in writing shall, on request, be executed, acknowledged and delivered by the District.

Any corporation into which the Escrow Agent, or any successor to it in the trusts created by this Agreement, may be merged or converted or with which it or any successor to it may be consolidated, or any corporation resulting from any merger, conversion, consolidation or reorganization to which the Escrow Agent or any successor to it shall be a party or any corporation to which the Escrow Agent or successor to it shall sell or transfer all or substantially all of its corporate trust business, shall be the successor Escrow Agent under this Agreement without the execution or filing of any paper or any other act on the part of any of the parties hereto, anything herein to the contrary notwithstanding.

SECTION 17. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT. Except as provided in Section 14 hereof, this Agreement shall terminate when all transfers and payments required to be made by the Escrow Agent under the provisions hereof shall have been made. Upon such termination and payment of all moneys set forth on Schedule A attached hereto, all moneys remaining in the Escrow Fund shall be released to the District.

SECTION 18. GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement shall be governed by the applicable laws of the State of Florida.

SECTION 19. SEVERABILITY. If any one or more of the covenants or agreements provided in this Agreement on the part of the District or the Escrow Agent to be performed should be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be contrary to law, such covenant or agreement shall be deemed and construed to be severable from the remaining covenants and agreements herein contained and shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Agreement.

SECTION 20. COUNTERPARTS. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, all or any of which shall be regarded for all purposes as one original and shall constitute and be but one and the same instrument.

SECTION 21. NOTICES. Any notice, authorization, request or demand required or permitted to be given in accordance with the terms of this Agreement shall be in writing and sent by registered or certified mail addressed to:
