Mr. Chang discussed the issue with the sidewalks and that they should be looked at via ADA criteria. Mr. Chang said at the next meeting he would have a full report with possible costs to make necessary repairs.

- 50 Supervisor Wright brought up the possibility of replacing oak trees to avoid sidewalk damage.
- 51 Supervisor Behrens inquired as to how long the repairs would last if they leave the oak trees. Mr.
- 52 Chang said it depends but usually about 5 years. Supervisor Randolph said the recourse should
- be that the CDD goes to the HOA to limit liability.

Mr. Lamb let the Board know that the previous engineer is going to provide CAD files to Mr. Chang to help develop a detailed map as requested at last meeting.

The complaint about the failing repair to the road was brought up. Supervisor Wright stated in order to figure out the proper repair we need to get plans for studies on streets from the previous engineer.

Sonny Shirvis of First Choice Aquatic discussed the recent algae bloom and how it is being treated. He stated that some ponds are lacking littoral shelf plantings and he explained the benefits of the plantings. He discussed the benefits of adding fish to some ponds and aeration. There was a discussion about the perimeter of the large pond at the community entrance. Mr. Shirvis stated he would provide recommendation as to which ponds should receive carpe and develop a proposal for aeration.
